**Call to order**

**Engineer's Report**

**Old Business**

The water rate increase that was approved by the Board will begin October 1<sup>st</sup>. **Len Kinter made a motion to approve the letter to the customers on the rate increase for water as amended. Glenn Baggley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

**New Business**

Bill Davis reported Sewickley is using Aleppo water temporarily. The Board questioned if the rate was high enough. Nicole Harris and Chris Lovato will pull the agreement out between Sewickley and Aleppo water to confirm how the rate is calculated and if it should be updated.

Sewickley and Leetsdale are reportedly in talks to send Sewickley customer sewage to Leetsdale. The Board questioned how that would affect Aleppo. Dave Kerchner will request a copy of the engineer study from Leetsdale.

Nicole Harris reported an Aleppo resident had a water leak in their meter pit. The customer asked for forgiveness on the sewer fees for the leak. The Board gave Nicole permission to approach Sewickley to request the forgiveness.
