

**ALEPPO TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY  
MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 23, 2023**

**Call to order**

Chairman Tim Merrill called the meeting to order at 4:30. Those present were Glenn Baggle, Rick Starr, Rich Zahrobsky, Dan O'Malley, Solicitor Harlan Stone, and Engineer Kevin Szakelydidi.

**Minutes**

Rick Starr made a motion to approve the January meeting minutes, Dan O'Malley seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Financials**

Rich Zahrobsky made a motion to ratify the prepaid water and sewer bill lists, Rick Starr seconded.

Dan O'Malley made a motion to pay the February water and sewer bill lists, Rick Starr seconded.

Rich Zahrobsky made a motion to approve the financial reports, Rick Starr seconded.

All three motions passed unanimously.

**Engineer's report**

Kevin S. reported the Authority received three bids for the Red Gate Road waterline replacement project. **Dan O'Malley made a motion to approve Jet Jack as the bid recipient at the lowest bidder at \$178,000. Rich Zahrobsky seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

**Glenn Baggle made a motion to approve the 2023 water and sewer budgets., Rich Zahrobsky seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

Kevin S. reported Masonic proposed the tie in for Trapp's sewer line on Red Gate be slightly adjusted. Three easements will now be necessary but all three are Masonic properties so one easement agreement should be sufficient. Harlan Stone will draft the developer's agreement.

**Rick Starr made a motion to approve Bankson apply for a second grant for the Deer Run Pump Station improvements. Glenn Baggle seconded. The motion passed unanimously.** The Authority now has two grant applications for the project out for approval.

**Solicitor's report**

Harlan Stone reported Mygrant Glass (Sewickley LCC) has one more sewer easement waiting for final approval and signatures.

Harlan reported all Authorities expire and the Board should be aware of that date to begin the process of renewing the Authority in a timely manner. The process may take a little longer and the Authority

should not wait until the last minute to begin. Harlan will proved the Board with that expiration date so it is on the radar.

**New business**

Bill Davis reported a rep from WC Weil is scheduled to present the history of the problems at the Deer Run Pump Station to the Board on 3/13. Nicole Harris will run an ad to advertise the special meeting.

**Old business**

The Authority had previously approved the engineers to apply for a grant to supply sewage to the Kilbuck Run Watershed area. The study showed it to be not feasible. The Board decided to pull the application due to the fact Sewickley Sewage could not confirm they are capable/able to receive the new sewage flows that would be added with the project. **Rich Zahrobsky made a motion to ratify the withdrawal of the application for the Kilbuck Run sewer project grant, Rick Starr seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

**Adjourn**

**Glenn Baggley made a motion to adjourn at 5:14, Rick Starr seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**
